Scotgrass 2010 adds slurry handling to its Ecosyl sponsored return to SAC Crichton Royal, Dumfries

The AEA is pleased to announce that next year's Scotgrass event, to be held on Tuesday 11 May 2010, will return to Acrehead Farm, at the SAC Dairy Research Unit, Crichton Royal, Dumfries and is again to be sponsored by Ecosyl Products.
